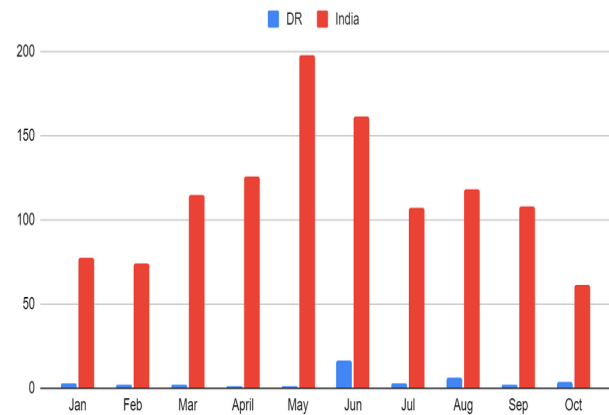

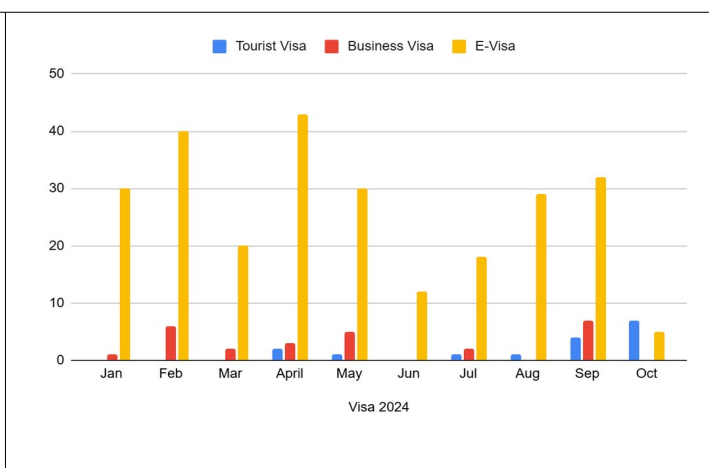

1. On 7 Oct 2024, ASO Com and Marketing Assistant met with Ms Yamile Morillo from Sri Sri Tattva to discuss issue of importing Ghee from India. She mentioned that they have imported samples from India for registering India as supplier of this product with Ministry of Health. Ministry of Health sent a communication to DR Customs in this regard. However, the consignment is held by Dominican Customs in consultation with Ministry of Agriculture (as it is not a registered product from India). We advised her to share a copy of communication sent by Ministry of Health to DR Customs and registration application with the Embassy to take it up with DR Customs. She was also advised to request Ministry of Health to send similar request to Ministry of Agriculture.
2. A 3 member delegation from Dominican Republic from 19 - 20 September 2024, participated in World Food India (WFI): Manuel Martin Morillo Martinez, Centro Cuesta Nacional (CCN), Daniel Batista, Bravo Supermarket, César José Valdez Garcia, Aldi Dominicana.
3. A 11 member delegation from Dominican Republic from 25 - 29 September 2024, participated in the UP International Fair: Melissa Sánchez, Jose Sanchez Comercial; Pedro Breton, Logic Paq LTD, Global Management; Fabiola Morales, CANA COLA BOTTLING, S.R.L.; Carlos Francisco Marte, D'Arquitectura RD; Osiris Volquez, DOS GARCIA, SRL; Xiossy Roa, Laboratorio Químico Dominicano, SAS - LABOQUIDOM; Grecia Julissa Moreno de Celado. Laboratorio Químico Dominicano, SAS - LABOQUIDOM; Manuel Ramon Celado Vallejo, Laboratorio Químico Dominicano, SAS LABOQUIDOM; César José Valdez García, Aldi Dominicana; Adria Gómez, Bravo Supermarket; Hillary Chapman, Caribe Express.
4. A 25 members delegation from Dominican Republic with following details is participating in World Telecommunication Standardization Assembly (WTSA-24) from 15-24 October 2024 and Global Standards Symposium (GSS-24) on 14 October 2024, in New Delhi, India. Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MIREX) – 5; Dominican Institute of Telecommunications (INDOTEL) – 5; Governmental Office of Information and Communication Technologies (OGTIC) – 3; Technological Institute of the Americas (ITLA) – 3; University of the Caribbean (UNICARIBE) – 2; Federico Henriquez y Carvajal University (UFHEC) – 6; Technological Institute of Santo Domingo (INTEC) – 1.
5. 18 October 2024, Ambassador along with SS Com met with Mr. Leandro Villanueva, Director General of DIGEMAPS, Ministry of Public Health and Social Assistance, Government of the Dominican Republic. The meeting was aimed to have an update regarding the proposal for recognition and acceptance of the Indian Pharmacopoeia (IP) in the Dominican Republic and subsequently adoption of Janaushadhi (Public Medicines) Scheme. The Director General informed that the proposal is submitted for review to Medical Assessment Board which constitutes doctors, pharmacists and scientific professionals. He also informed that DR signed Pharmacopoeia agreements only with three countries so far i.e. USA, Mexico and United Kingdom. He assured to provide an outcome by end of October 2024.
6. 18 October 2024, Ambassador along with SS Com met with Mr. Hugo Rivera, Vice – Minister of Economic Affairs & International Cooperation, Ministry of External Relations. The meeting was regarding the first meeting of India – Dominican Republic Joint Economic and Trade Committee (JETCO) scheduled to be held in India. Ambassador invited Vice Minister to lead a delegation to India to participate in the first JETCO meeting and Foreign Office Consultations. The Vice- Minister responded positively and assured to propose two sets of dates for his visit to India.
7. On 22 October 2024, A Virtual Meeting was held between Dr. Jorge Morales Paulino, Vice Minister of Ministry of Commerce and SMEs of Dominican Republic and Indian Railway Company RITES on the proposal for conducting a new feasibility study to be carried by Indian railway companies for a freight train between Santo Domingo and Santiago. In April 2001, IRCON and RITES jointly conducted the feasibility study for construction of rail system. At that time, the proposal was in two phases, Phase I: 146 kms main line from Santo Domingo to Santiago; and Phase II: 58 km branch line from the main line. RITES confirmed

that they would send an Expression of Interest with details of requirements to be fulfilled by the DR Govt. for pre-feasibility study. It was agreed to identify a designated point of contact in DR to provide required information to RITES.

8. On 24 October 2024, the Embassy of India in Santo Domingo, organized an event titled “Indian Automobile Industry: Opportunities for Dominican Republic Business” in collaboration with the Indian Chamber of Commerce, and the Anamara Auto Association of the Dominican Republic in the premises of Chamber of Commerce of Santo Domingo. The event aimed to explore synergies between the Indian and Dominican auto mobile industries and showcase potential opportunities for collaboration. A presentation offering insights into India’s evolving industrial landscape, specifically highlighting opportunities in the auto sector, was made in the event. The event also included a presentation on Bharat Mobility Expo to be held in India from 17 to 22 January, 2025 with nine parallel events. Approximately 30 prominent business delegates from the Dominican Republic’s auto industry participated, including representatives from Magna Motors, Lama Motors, Grupo Haina, Equimax and other major automotive businesses. A virtual presentation on the upcoming Bharat Mobility Expo 2025 was delivered by representative from the Engineering Export Promotion Council of India (EEPC). The presentation outlined the scope and potential of the Indian automobile industry and the technological advancements being showcased at the expo. Dominican business leaders shared their experiences of conducting automotive business with Indian companies, primarily focusing on collaborations with Bajaj, Hyundai& Asok Levland. Spanish publication of commercial booklet titled “Exploring New India 2024” were provided to all the guests. Dominican businesses were encouraged to participate in the Bharat Mobility Expo 2025, positioning the event as a platform to explore new business opportunities, partnerships, and innovations in the Indian auto mobile sector. The event facilitated productive discussions and strengthened the commercial ties between the Indian and Dominican Republic automotive industries.

9. On 24 October 2024, SS Com along with ASO (Com) and Marketing assistant, attended the inauguration of the XXVIII edition of the Bolsa Turística del Caribe (Caribbean Tourism Exchange) BTC. This 3-day event included business meetings, presentations of tourism products, gastronomic experiences, among others.

10. On 28 october 2024, Ambassador met with Mr. Limber Cruz Lopez, Minister of Agriculture and Mr. Dario Arcide Vargas Mena, Vice Minister of Agricultural Extension and Training and Mrs. Rosa Elena Tejada Sánchez, Head of the International Cooperation Department in the Ministry to discuss areas of cooperation in agriculture sector and highlighted couple of issues related to import of Indian products viz. Egg powder, ghee into DR. Ambassador also discussed about the proposed MOU on Sanitary and Phytosanitary Matters between the Ministry of Agriculture of Dominican Republic and Ministry of Agriculture and farmers Welfare of the Republic of India. Vice Minister has shown keen interest in Indian agriculture machinery & equipment like generators, water pumps, solar power etc. A point of contact Mr. Victor Rodríguez was established to discuss and resolve the issues of import of Indian products.
