## Sri Lanka to set up Tourism Commission

Sri Lanka will combine existing agencies and set up a Tourism Commission for the sector, the Indian Ocean Island's Foreign and Tourism Minister said. Unlike other export sectors, which takes time to revive, tourism is an area where quick wins can be scored, The National People's Power had a plan for the sector he said. Work will begin next year.

## Sri Lanka central bank ready for vehicle import relaxation

Sri Lanka's Central Bank has indicated its readiness to support the government if it chooses to relax motor vehicle import restrictions, citing the country's stable balance of payments position and a current account surplus for the second consecutive year.

## Ceylon chamber ready to work with new government on economic stability

The Ceylon Chamber of Commerce has says it's ready to collaborate with the new administration to foster economic stability. "The Ceylon Chamber stands ready to collaborate with the new administration to foster economic stability, inclusive growth, and sustainable development," the trade body said in a statement. Chamber Chairman Duminda Hulangamuwa is also an economic advisor the President Anura Dissanayake, whose party the National People's Power won a landslide in the parliamentary election.

Sri Lanka is planning to call bids to develop two 500 Megawatt wind plants offshore of Mannar and Puttalam after feasibility studies are concluded in 2027, Ceylon Electricity Board Chairman Tilak Siyambalapitiya said. The CEB has to make detailed environmental studies, sea floor, and logistics before calling for bids, Siyambalapitiya told a forum organized by Sri Lanka's Export Development Board.
