

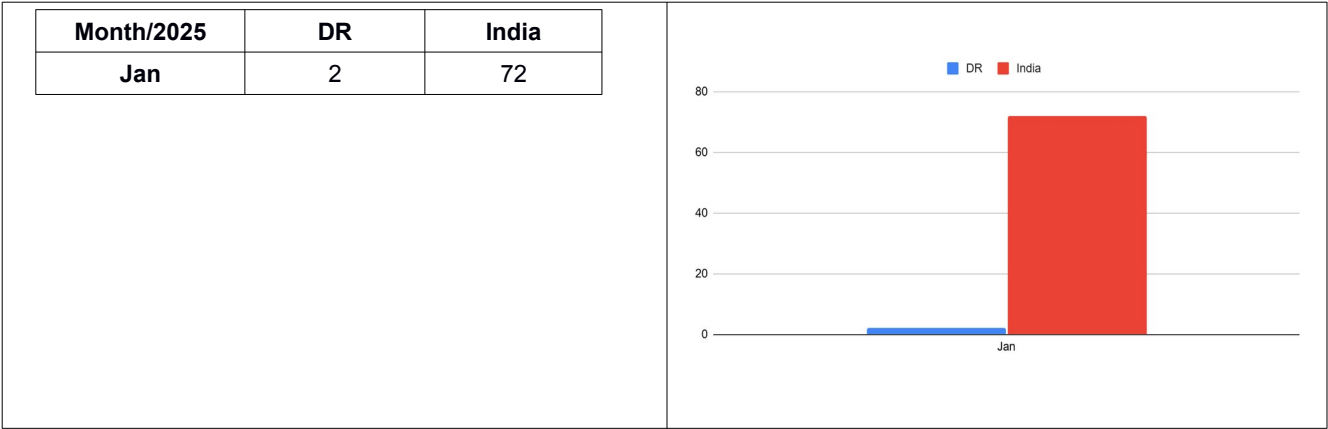

On 2 January 2025, SS Com attended the Virtual Meeting to discuss Finalization of the contours of and Tender Notice for Design, development, modular launch, beta-testing, bugs-removal, stabilization of AI/ML powered portal PartnerIndia.org, as a platform to promote 5Ts – Trade, Technology, Tourism, Talent and Tradition, connect between private sectors and stakeholders from India and LAC (Latin America and Caribbean) countries.
2. On 08 January 2025, Ambassador along with SS Com met with Mr. Karthick, country manager Latin America, of an Indian company Bull Machines Pvt. Ltd., which manufactures construction equipment. He informed that their company is supplying construction equipment to Dominican Republic. They have already exported 10 machines and in process of sending 5 more machines. Ambassador assured cooperation from the Embassy to facilitate business between two countries.
3. On 15 January 2025, Embassy organized a Conference and Exhibition for promotion of One District One Product (ODOP) in coordination with Invest India. Several products, procured by the Embassy from registered ODOP vendors in India, were showcased at the event. Mr Hugo Rivera Fernández, Vice-Minister for Economic Affairs and International Cooperation of Dominican Republic (DR) and Dr. Jorge Morales Paulino, Vice Minister for Promotion of Micro, Small and Medium Industries of DR attended the event. Both Vice Ministers addressed the audience after my welcome remarks. A video on ODOP was screened. Mr. David Mármol, President of Indian Chamber of Commerce in DR emphasized the importance of India as promising business partner for DR. Shri Rahees M, Director DPIIT made a virtual presentation highlighting the significance of ODOP. A gathering of approx 70 including members of Chamber of Commerce, DR Business delegates, diplomatic corps, and local media, attended the exhibition.
4. On 16 January 2025, Ambassador along with SS Com met a delegation from INFOTEP comprising Mr. Rafael Santos Badía, Director of INFOTEP; Mr. Edgar Pimentel, International Cooperation Director and Michelle Sigarán, Deputy Director of International Cooperation. Director expressed their interest to send teachers to India for training in the field of IT & Software and Mathematics. Ambassador advised Director to lead a delegation to India and assured cooperation to facilitate meetings with relevant institutions in India. Ambassador also suggested three Indian institutions viz. Center for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC), National Small Industries Corporation (NSIC) and National Skill Development Corporation to undertake training and assured to provide training slots to INFOTEP under ITEC Programme of MEA.
5. On 22 January 2025, Ambassador met with Mr. Alberto Leroux - President, Mr. Tomas Marcano- 2nd Vice President, Mr. Jorge Jerez - General Secretary, Mr. Jose Frías - Fair Director & Mr. Ronald Rodríguez - Executive Director of the National Council of Trade in Supplies (CNCP). The central focus of the discussion was the upcoming "Expo Provisiones 2025," scheduled to take place from May 29th to June 1st at Sambil, and to extended invitation to participate as the Guest Country at this prestigious fair.
6. On 24 January 2025, SS Com had an interactive session with Rector of UFHEC, UNIREMHOS, UNEFA, head of Indotel and professors of the universities who visited India for WTSA. They shared their experiences for their visit and participation in the WTSA. SS Com shared information on various upcoming trade fairs and business opportunities in India, emphasizing the potential for greater collaboration between DR & India.

7. On 28 January 2025, Ambassador along with SS Com met with Mr. Oscar Bonnelly from Terminaciones Españolas in Santiago. Mr. Bonnelly has shown interest in importing Ceramic tiles, machinery for modular kitchen, raw materials for manufacturing windows/ doors and office desks from India. He also expressed interest to import MDF wood and innovations in construction field from India. Ambassador advised him to visit India in relevant trade fairs and exhibitions and assured to provide details.
