(6 digit HS tariff line) 300490: Pharmaceutical products (medicaments for therapeutic / prophylactic purposes)	Kuwait's imports of pharmaceutical products reached about USD 1.665 billion in 2021, of which India's market share was 0.56 percent (as per ITC data). Of this, Kuwait's imports in this category majorly consist of HS code 300490 (medicaments other than antibiotics consisting of mixed or unmixed products) which forms almost 53% of Kuwait's total imports. India has a market share of 0.56% in this category as well, despite being the 10 th largest exporter globally, with exports worth USD 14 billion in 2021. Lack of local manufacturing and dependency on imports, as well as a large expat population for which Kuwait seeks to provide cost-effective healthcare, may drive the need for affordable generic pharmaceutical products in the near future. By value, medicaments were the 4 th largest import product in Kuwait in 2021, forming 2.73% of Kuwait's total imports. Kuwait largely imports pharmaceutical products from Germany, USA, France, Denmark, Switzerland and the UK. Consumer preferences, acceptability by medical fraternity and existing distributor networks are some of the major market entry barriers that need to be tackled to increase India's share in this large pharmaceutical market, especially after the Kuwaiti government has allowed import of generic pharamaceutical products.
2.	711319: Articles of Jewelry	This is the 2 nd largest commodity by value that Kuwait imported in 2021, amounting to USD 1.188 billion, showing a growth of almost 150% YOY. India was the second largest exporter to Kuwait in this category, with USD 109 million worth of exports and a market share of 9.21%. Top exporter was the UAE with exports worth USD 764 million – almost 65% market share. It is to be taken into account that India's indirect market share may be substantially higher given that much of the Indian jewelry exported to UAE is re-exported to Kuwait. As such, ease of direct exports to Kuwait may be explored for potential trade benefit.
3	100199: Wheat and Meslin	Kuwait imported USD 156.79 million worth of wheat in 2021.

		India's share was only 0.01 percent in Kuwait's imports of this commodity, amounting to USD 31,000. India's largest export of wheat to Kuwait was observed in 2013 at USD 878 million worth of exports, the first time Kuwait imported wheat from India. However, since then, exports have completely fallen to miniscule amounts, averaging at USD 77 million over the past 8 years. India's global exports of wheat amounted to USD 1.7 billion in 2021, a growth of over 600% YOY. A single country viz Australia is dominating this market, with a share of over 80%. Indian exports can target this market anomaly and get a decent share. Presence of large Indian-owned supermarkets like Lulu, Grand Hyper provides an easily tappable retail supply chain network.
4	901890: Instruments and appliances used in medical, surgical or veterinary sciences	Kuwait imported about USD 245.5 million worth of items categorized as optical, photographic, cinematographic, measuring, checking, precision, medical or surgical instruments and apparatus in 2021, of which HS code 901980 (Medical instruments and appliances) amounted to USD 121.6 milllion (about 50% of total imports). India's share in Kuwait's imports was about 0.21% (USD 262,000), a negative growth of about 26% YOY, while India's global exports for this product amounted to USD 340 million in 2021 demonstrating a growth of almost 15% YOY. Similar to the market for pharmaceuticals and wheat, market for medical/surgical appliances is dominated by few countries such as the USA (which enjoys an almost 23% of the market share as per 2021 figures), followed by there is a considerable scope for competitive products from India.
5	401110: Pneumatic rubber tyres for motor cars	Kuwait imported USD 121.12 million worth of pneumatic rubber tyres in 2021. India's share in Kuwait's imports was about 1.2% (USD 1.4 million). India exported a total of USD 173 million worth of pneumatic car tyres globally in 2021, which is not commensurate with India's market share in Kuwait's imports. As is with several other commodities, this sector is also dominated with few key players, with China, Japan and Korea accounting for over 72% of market share.
6	040221: Milk and cream in solid forms, of a fat content by weight of > 1.5%, unsweetened	Kuwait's total imports of dairy products in 2021 was USD 302 million, of which milk and cream accounted for USD 140 million (about 46% of total dairy imports). India's share in Kuwait's imports of unsweetened milk and cream was only this category was only 0.72% with exports worth USD 0.49 million. As is with many products, one country viz. Netherlands has a lion's share in the Kuwaiti market (almost 60%), followed by New Zealand and Australia. Although a fair amount of Indian products may be entering into Kuwait via UAE, and as such are unaccounted for when looking at direct trade data, exports for dairy products from India to Kuwait could be explored.
